What is the RAP?

The Resource Assistants Program is a rigorous, immersive work and learning experience that provides exposure to the Forest Service, developmental and training opportunities, and the chance to make a lasting contribution that will impact generations to come. As a Resource Assistant, you will be assigned critical work important to delivering the Forest Service's mission of caring for and managing our public lands.



THE PROGRAM

- 24 weeks/6 months
- \$500/ week living stipend
- \$1000/ month housing stipend
- Travel, training, and commuter allowance
- Health insurance offered
- Virtual and in-person positions
- Mentorship and hands-on training
- Certificate issued at completion with Direct Hire and Non-Competitive Hiring Authority
